- 4"x4" Gauze Pad
- Iodine Prep Pads
- 6" x 9" Cold Pack
- Hydrogen Peroxide
- Towels
- Alcohol Prep Pads
- Surgical Scrub Brush
- Blunt Tip Scissors
- Saline Solution
- Syringe
- Tourniquet
- Gloves
- Roll of Cotton
- Flashlight
