

DISASTER PREPARATION FOR YOUR PETS

PREP CHECKLIST

- ☐ Carrier for each pet that is labeled with pet's name, veterinarian info, your name and current contact information – all other items can be stored in pet carrier for easy access during emergency
- ☐ Favorite toys, favorite treats and other familiar/comfort items
- ☐ Extra blankets and/or familiar bedding
- ☐ Collar with up-to-date IDs, harness and leash
- ☐ Microchip all pets and keep registered contact information current
- ☐ Handouts with contact information and photos of you and pet(s) (*in case pet becomes lost*)
- ☐ Vet contact info, boarding instructions, list of current medications/illnesses/allergies, medical records and proof of ownership (*such as city pet license*) in waterproof container/bag
- ☐ Plastic poop bags and newspaper for dogs; litter box, scoop and extra litter for cats
- ☐ Cleaning supplies for accidents (*paper towels, disinfectant, trash bags, etc.*)
- ☐ At least 2 week supply of medication and treats for administration
- ☐ At least 2 week supply of food in airtight, waterproof container or cans
- ☐ At least 2 week supply of water
- ☐ Food and water bowls, manual can opener and liquid dish soap for cleaning bowls



FIRST AID CHECKLIST

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| ☐ Anti-diarrheal liquid or tablets | ☐ Saline solution |
| ☐ Antibiotic ointment | ☐ Towel and washcloth |
| ☐ Bandage tape and scissors | ☐ Tweezers |
| ☐ Cotton bandage rolls and gauze | ☐ Milk of Magnesia Activated Charcoal |
| ☐ Flea and tick prevention | ☐ Hydrogen Peroxide (3%) |
| ☐ Isopropyl alcohol/alcohol prep pads | ☐ Digital thermometer - Fever thermometer |
| ☐ Latex gloves | ☐ Eye dropper |
